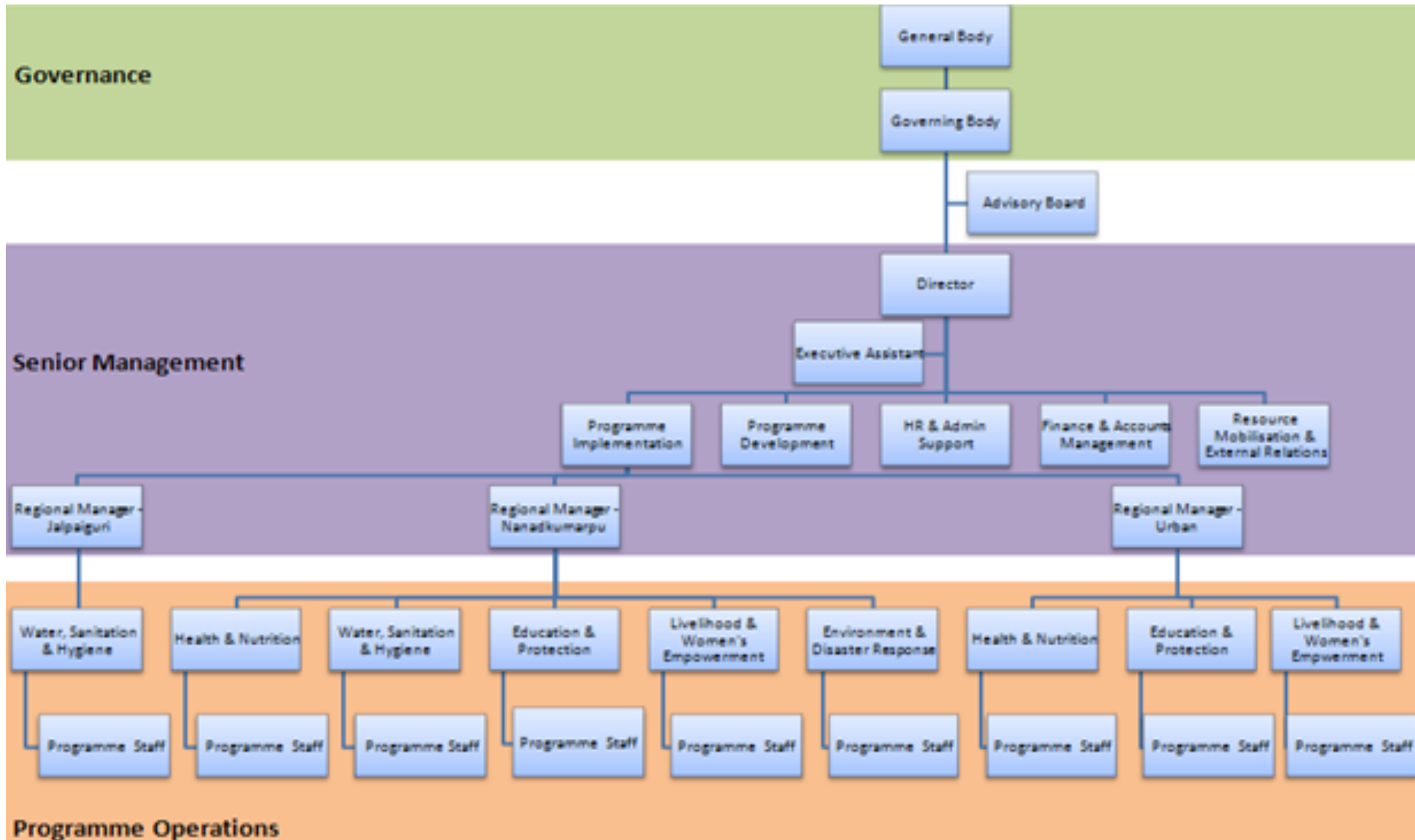

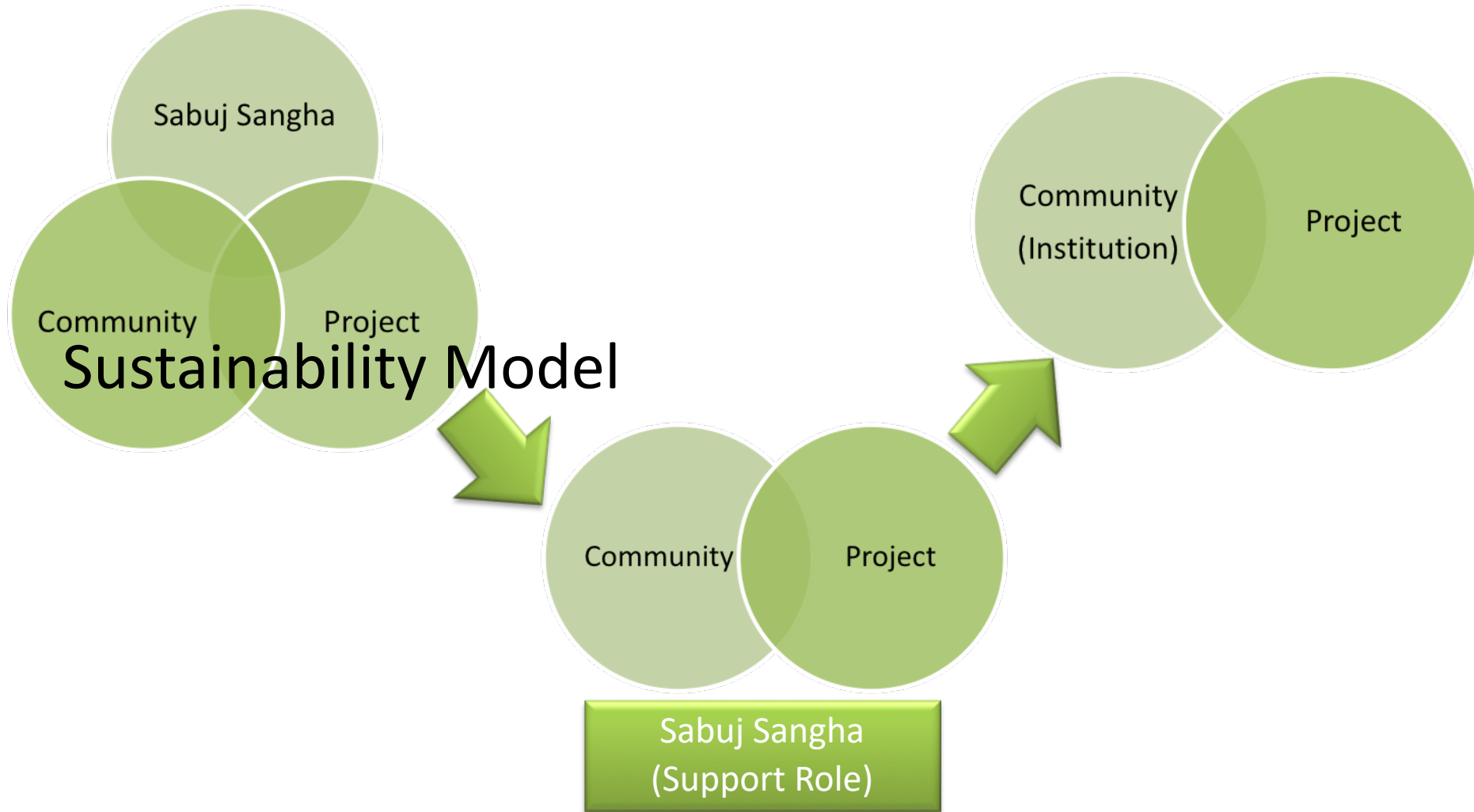

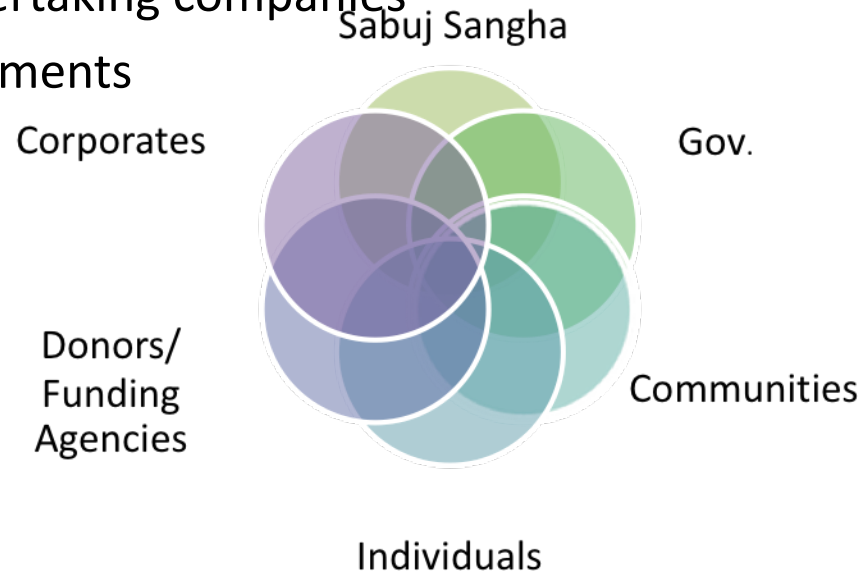
# Road Ahead
